Rates

Monthly tuition rates per student for lessons occurring with Annaka Hogelin in the Imperfect Music Studio:

Group lessons are available for in-person clarinet, saxophone, and flute students only. All students must play the same instrument and be of a similar age and/or playing level.

Monthly tuition rates include most method books and sheet music. Other supplies & equipment are the responsibility of the student and/or parent.

Monthly tuition will be reevaluated annually, with any changes taking effect in August.

Payment Methods & Due Dates

Lessons are to be paid for on a monthly basis, due at the first lesson of each month by check or Square.

Payment for the lessons are due at the first lesson of each month. Acceptable payments include check or by credit card via Square. Square includes a service fee (3.3% for invoices, 1% for ACH transfer, and 2.6% for Point of Sale). Via Square you may set up a recurring payment, which would be processed on the 1st day of each month.

PayPal, Zelle, and Venmo are not currently accepted.

Discounts & Referrals

For families with one student enrolled in full price lessons, any additional sibling enrolling in lessons will be granted a 10% discount. Additionally, if a student is enrolled in more than one weekly lesson (e.g., saxophone & piano), the same discount applies.

For each student you successfully refer to the Imperfect Music Studio, you will receive a one-time 25% tuition discount.

For committed students with financial need, please contact Annaka to schedule an audition & interview and discuss the Imperfect Music Studio scholarship program.

There will be no regularly scheduled lessons the following dates:

Illness, Absences, and Inclement Weather

Lessons will take place virtually (e.g. via a service like Zoom, Facetime, or Skype) in the event of inclement weather or transportation issues. Please test your microphone with your instrument in advance, troubleshooting technological issues will be considered part of your lesson time.

In the event that a lesson will be missed, at least **24 hours notice** is required to reschedule the missed lesson. No refunds will be given.

Students **may not come to lessons while sick** (e.g. flu, covid, cold, etc.). In the case of a mild, but contagious, illness the lessons will switch to a virtual format at the students regularly scheduled time. If the illness is more severe, and the student is not able to participate virtually, the same options are available as for any missed lesson.

With **24 hours notice**, lesson options in the event a missed lesson include:

- Signing up for a make-up lesson at the designated time at the end of the semester
- Asynchronous lesson (e.g., student submits video recording and will receive written comments)

- Swapping lesson times with another student later in the week, to be arranged by the student or guardian. Only students on the Swap List will receive the swap list. Sign up on the Student Information Form.

Expectations

Students must have their own equipment including their instrument in good condition, multiple broken-in reeds (if applicable), music, notebook, tuner (if applicable), metronome, and other materials as needed. Upgrades to equipment may also be recommended.

You must be punctual. If you are late for a lesson, that is time that you will forfeit. This time will not be rescheduled, and no refund will be given.

Practice is of utmost importance when improving musical skills. Students will be given instructions for practice and will have music to prepare for each lesson.

Termination of Lessons

By signing this agreement, you are committing to lessons on a monthly basis. Termination of lessons must be made at the end of the month. Any money that has been paid in advance will not be refunded if the student chooses to terminate lessons in the middle of the month. In making a commitment to you, I expect the same in return in order to have successful lessons.
